

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- ➤ Applicant must have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher
- Applicant must currently be an active member (involved in 1 or more ministries) of MSBC
- > Applicant must have documentation supporting community service or volunteer hours

SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS:

- > Completed application, including all required attachments, must be submitted by noon on April 1
- Scholarship is based on merit
- Applicant will be required to attend an interview session with the Scholarship Committee
- * LATE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED

REQUIRED ATTACHMENTS:

- ➤ 2 Letters of recommendation
- Verification of high school attendance report
- Official high school transcript
- Verification of community service
- An essay that was submitted with another scholarship or college application

Scholarship recipients must use their scholarship within 1 year of their graduation date, or the scholarship may be forfeited.
